Dear Mr Morgan

First let me thank you

for putting forth that slender little notice
of mine in the Ottawa paper with regard
to the precious little book I have already
made a friend of.

Now let me
tell you that I have not received
the prospectus of which you speak.

We have a perfectly appalling P. O.
"System" here. The P. O. is a tiny shack
and the letters are thrown about anyhow.
We have a box or rather rat-hole

for our mail. So has the Bank of
Toronto. Last week the Bank lost
several letters. No one can account for
them. The ~~foreign~~ (Iardon!) foreigners - Italians,
French, Finn, Spanish, Galicians, Turks
Prussians make a wild "grab" or dive
among the bunches of letters. I know I am
losing more than one every day -
The rusty old mail stage rattles away
over the roughest of roads with the one poor
mail bag and the Lord only knows what
happens. I will do all I can
for you of course, but as to all that
I shall need some pointers from
